Tuition:

Tuition for Leadership Fremont is \$600 per participant for Chamber members, \$700 per participant for non-Chamber members and \$500 for qualifying non-profits. Registration includes retreat, sessions, meals, collateral materials, site visits, and final banquet.

Deadline:

If fewer than 30 businesses apply, an additional applicant from Chamber businesses will be considered. If needed, we'll contact Chamber member business leadership with multiple applications to determine application priority. All applicants will be notified of acceptance status by email.
